

and limitation may be returned unto the world duly for the use of the good people for
 the time being of the severall townes and villages aforesaid, wch alle the tithing and tithing
 of the said good churches within the towne of Althorp aforesaid. And my will and maner
 is that for every year and year that my said friends trust as aforesaid, and the thirtieth
 of the year next following shall for ever hereafter once in every year make and
 allivise at my said Messuage or tenement on the thirtieth day of May if he say you not to
 be in, withouth day, and if not then the next day after, and there shall come in a booke of account
 to be provided out of the rent and profits of the premises from time to time for that
 year, a true and just reckoning and account of all the monies they have received, and
 wch in the year before out of or for the premises, and how and in what manner in a
 particular they have bestowed and bestowed of the same according to my true meaning
 in regard to this my will, and my will is that every auditors and account my said justice,
 and the profits of the premises for the time being shall have an allowance out of the
 rent and profits of the premises for that year for our meals, the charges wherof not
 exceeding forty shillings, and my will is that such booke and booke of account and accounts
 and such receipts and discharges as shall under the charges of the premises according
 to this my will together with this my will, and all the said articles, books, receipts and
 discharges, and true records under or by or for the premises be at aforesaid shall from
 time to time safely kept in my said messuage in a strong and sufficient chest with other strong
 lock and that each to be provided for that purpose at the charges of my executors, and all in
 a convenient and safe place in the said Messuage, which chest hath to be and remaine from
 time to time in the safe custody of such one of the said Trustees and Sheriff of the premises
 for the time being as shall be named and appointed in the tenor of aforesaid charter, and also
 my will and hereunto my will is that for every year and year that my said friends
 trust in trust of the premises for the time being shall yearly for ever after my death have
 and enjoy to them their part out of the rent, issue and profits of the premises, the sum of four
 quents of lawful money of England, to be equally divided amongst them, for this rate
 of six pence and a half in each about the proportion of this my will and thereafter as. And
 my will is that my said friends, Sheriff in trust of the premises, for the time being shall
 deliver and be allowed upon their said receipt and account out of the rent and profits
 of the premises, all such sums and sums of money, rent, charges and expenses as they or
 either of them shall at any time after my death, her death or death, or be put into or about the
 repayment of the premises, or in about or be taken of the distress of the title thereof, or of
 any part thereof, or in about or concerning the payment of the rent or trust herein contained,
 and the same allowance charge and expense to be allowed from time to time upwards and
 down in the said booke and booke of account. And all my will is that from and after my
 death my executors, Administrators, Sheriffs, shall come and make and hold every and every
 my said Messuage and tenement and premises for and during the term of five hundred
 and fourty and if referred in and by the above written letters patents. And alle the charges
 further providing her selfe my said Trustees and Sheriffs in trust for the premises
 for the time being the year to come and year of their chief profits to be bestowed in this manner
 that it to be as they provide those of be reasonable for the relief of good people in the severall
 townes and villages aforesaid in manner as herein is before nominated, and the officers of the
 shire, or officers of the Sheriff's office, and to pay such for their allowance, and charges
 as they shall require, provided always, and my will is that if after my death, the
 year next following of the premises shall not be to defray and pay the said the former
 year, and the said year shall, and when the allowance charge and expense before mentioned, in
 this my will is that every such year and year a certain and proportionable allowance to be
 made, as well of the said Messuage and premises, as of any other premises and appoynted to
 me for the benefit of the good people for the time being of the severall townes and villages
 aforesaid as well out of the said sum of four quents allowed as aforesaid to my said
 Sheriff.
